



Information for Preparation: Individual Interview



Dear applicant,

We are very pleased about your interest in our Master's Programme *Digital Transformation & Sustainability*. Based on your written documents and the successful telephone interview, we would like to get to know you personally. Therefore, we invite you to our Admission Day. At the end of this Admission Day, a one-on-one interview will take place with you, which is explained in more detail below.

The Master's programme is in many ways a very innovative study programme. In a teaching and learning community of teachers, students, organisations and project partners, we want to live collaborative learning and contribute to the implementation of the 17 Sustainable Development Goals (SDGs). We want a learning culture in which we work in an appreciative and respectful way, working together in a committed and motivated manner. Therefore, we want to get to know you as well as possible and give you the opportunity to decide if HSBA and the programme is also the perfect fit for you. We are interested in your attitude, motivation and your future plans as well projects, which you would like to work on during your studies and in what projects you want to get involved.

In addition to the content, we would also like to see that you have learned to work in a scientific programme as part of your Bachelor's degree in the presentation.

Beyond the time frame conditions, no formal requirements are made for the design of the presentation itself. It is up to you to convince us.
